## **Budget:**

- 1. Capital Budget: Rescue 1 Replacement Priority 1 by FinCom
- 2. Increases: (OSHA Compliance needs)
  - a. Stipends
  - b. Licensing
  - c. Software

#### Stations:

- 1. Role Equipment: Get Apparatus out the door
- 2. Use IAR Members need to log in to let everyone know they are coming
- Members need to let someone know if equipment is damaged or if an injury occurs on a call.

### Apparatus:

- 1. C-2 has ordered parts for intake valve on E23 (leaking)
- 2. Possibly mount a portable repeater on the new Rescue 1.

### Other:
